Service of the Word

Examination

- P The Bible is the Word of God
- All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, (2 Tim. 3:16)
- P One of the main teachings of the Bible is the Law
- For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, (Rom. 3:20)
- P The other main teaching of the Bible is the Gospel
- For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. (Rom. 1:16)
- P The Christian Faith relies upon the doctrine of the Trinity
- We worship one God in Trinity, and Trinity in Unity, neither confounding the persons, nor dividing the substance. For there is one person of the Father, another of the Son, and another of the Holy Spirit. But the Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit is all one, the glory equal, the majesty coeternal. (Athanasian Creed)
- P God created the world perfectly, but Adam and Eve fell into sin. Because of their sin, we all inherit original sin.
- Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me. (Ps. 51:5)
- P Rather than destroying the world and starting over, God loved us and had a plan.
- But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, ⁵ to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. (Gal. 4:4-5)

- P Jesus died on the cross to pay for the sins of the whole world and rose gain on the third day. What does His resurrection mean for us?
- Jesus resurrection assures us that: (1.) God has accepted His payment on our behalf. (2.) Jesus is who He claimed to be. (3.) We too will rise from the dead.
- P How does the Holy Spirit bring us to faith and keep us in the faith?
- The means of grace, which is the Gospel in Word and Sacrament.
- P What is Baptism?
- Baptism is not just plain water. It is water used by God's Command and connected with God's Word.
- P What are the benefits of Baptism?
- Baptism works the forgiveness of sins, delivers from death and the devil, and gives eternal salvation to all who believe, as the words and promises of God declare.
- P How can water do such great things?
- The water doesn't actually do anything by itself. The power is in God's Word, which is with the water, and the faith which trust the Word of God in the water.
- P What is the meaning of this baptism?
- It means that the Old Adam in us should be drowned by daily contrition and repentance and die with all sins and evil desires. It also means that a new Man should daily appear and arise, who lives eternally before God in righteousness and purity.
- P What is the Sacrament of the Altar?
- It is the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, given to us Christians under the bread and wine to eat and to drink, as it was instituted by Christ Himself.
- P What is the benefit of this eating and drinking?
- The words, "Given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sins," show us that God gives forgiveness of sins, life, and

salvation through the Sacrament. For where there is forgiveness of sins, there is also life and salvation.

- P How can simple eating and drinking do such great things?
- Eating and drinking actually do nothing. It is the words, "Given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sins," which do this. These words, together with the bodily eating and drinking are the main part of the sacrament. Whoever believes these words has exactly what they say: forgiveness of sins.
- P When is an individual properly prepared to receive this sacrament?
- A person is truly worthy and well-prepared who has faith in these words, "Given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sins." Whoever does not believe these words or doubts them is unworthy and unprepared. The words, "for you," require nothing but believing hearts.

Old Testament Lesson

Zechariah 9:9-12

⁹ Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey. ¹⁰ I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim and the war horse from Jerusalem; and the battle bow shall be cut off, and he shall speak peace to the nations; his rule shall be from sea to sea, and from the River to the ends of the earth. ¹¹ As for you also, because of the blood of my covenant with you, I will set your prisoners free from the waterless pit. ¹² Return to your stronghold, O prisoners of hope; today I declare that I will restore to you double.

Gospel Lesson

Luke 19:28-44

²⁸ And when he had said these things, he went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem. ²⁹ When he drew near to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount that is called Olivet, he sent two of the disciples, ³⁰ saying, "Go into the village in front of you, where on entering you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever yet sat. Untie it and bring it here. ³¹ If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' you shall say this: 'The Lord has need of it." ³² So those who were sent went away

and found it just as he had told them. 33 And as they were untying the colt, its owners said to them, "Why are you untying the colt?" 34 And they said, "The Lord has need of it." 35 And they brought it to Jesus, and throwing their cloaks on the colt, they set Jesus on it. 36 And as he rode along, they spread their cloaks on the road. 37 As he was drawing near-- already on the way down the Mount of Olives-the whole multitude of his disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen, 38 saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" 39 And some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples." 40 He answered, "I tell you, if these were silent, the very stones would cry out." 41 And when he drew near and saw the city, he wept over it, 42 saying, "Would that you, even you, had known on this day the things that make for peace! But now they are hidden from your eves. 43 For the days will come upon you, when your enemies will set up a barricade around you and surround you and hem you in on every side 44 and tear you down to the ground, you and your children within you. And they will not leave one stone upon another in you, because you did not know the time of your visitation."

Sermon:

1 Peter 2:1-10 NKJV

¹ So put away all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander. ² Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up into salvation-- ³ if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good. ⁴ As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God chosen and precious, ⁵ you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. ⁶ For it stands in Scripture: "Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone, a cornerstone chosen and precious, and whoever believes in him will not be put to shame." ⁵ So the honor is for you who believe, but for those who do not believe, "The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone," ⁵ and "A stone of stumbling, and a rock of offense." They stumble because they disobey the word, as they were destined to do. ⁵ But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own

possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. ¹⁰ Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.
